

Day 1: Monday, July 14, 2025: Departure Day. (M) Depart Minneapolis/St. Paul airport or Chicago O'Hare on our non-stop flight to Dublin. Relax onboard as you fly into Irish skies.


Day 2: Tuesday, July 15: Drogheda, Hill of Slane, Monasterboyce, **Downpatrick D** Arrive in Dublin early and travel north along some of Ireland's oldest Arrive at St. Peter's inhabited areas. Church in Drogheda where the relics of St. Oliver Plunkett can be found. Mass\* is celebrated here. Continue north to Monasterboyce, a monastery founded by St. Buithe, who died in 521. The name Monasterboyce is a part-anglicization of the Irish name Mainistir Bhuithe, meaning "monastery of Buithe". In Monasterboyce you will find the finest Celtic Cross in Our next stop on our morning Ireland. excursion is one of the most historic sites of Ireland's Catholic Faith, the Hill of Slane. This is the place where tradition tells us that St. Patrick, after having lit a fire during the pagan "night of darkness" (same night as the Easter Vigil), at great risk, evangelized the natives and their king regarding the Blessed Trinity, using a simple shamrock as the means for their conversion. Then continue to Northern Ireland to visit the reputed site of St. Patrick's Tomb in Downpatrick, which is also the site that houses the remains of St. Bridget and St. Columba. Afterwards, travel to Armagh area for our first night stay. Mass\* at St. Peter's Church in Drogheda

Dav 3: Wednesday, July 16 (Part 1): Armagh. (B, D) Travel to Armagh, which has been the spiritual capital of Ireland for over 1,500 years, to visit the imposing Cathedral of Armagh, seat of the Archbishop Primate of Ireland. Construction of St. Patrick's Roman Catholic Cathedral began in 1840, but because of the intervening famine years, was not completed until 1873. The Cathedral is an 🜠 imposing site, perched on the hilltop in Bridget and St. Columba Armagh and dominating its skyline. The church was designed and built in Neo

Gothic style from pale limestone, with large twin spires. [Continued on next column]

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

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Day 3: (Continued) Wednesday, July 16: Tobernalt & Knock (continued).

Then travel west to County Sligo. Visit the Holy Well of Tobernalt where Mass\* is celebrated at the famous Mass Rock, where Priests celebrated Mass secretly during the penal times, known for the harsh persecutions against Catholics. Local tradition tells us that St. Patrick himself was here, and left a hand print on the old altar. This place is of great importance for the defense of the freedom to worship and a commemoration for all those who persevered in practicing their Faith in times of persecution, even if it meant endangering their lives. Afterwards, drive south west to one of the highlights of our pilgrimage, the

famous Marian Shrine of Knock, where the Virgin Mary appeared to 15 people on August 21, 1879. Rosary is prayed at the site of the apparitions. Arrive at our hotel in Knock (hotel may be in another town in County Mayo), and check-in for our 2-night stay. Mass\* requested at Tobernalt (Armagh Cathedral or Knock are weather back up locations).



Day 4: Thursday, July 17: Shrine of Our Lady of Knock (B, D After your full Irish breakfast, enjoy a full day at the Marian Shrine of Knock. There we will pray a rosary while we walk around the shrine. Confessions follow and free time to explore the shrine's different areas like the Way of the Cross, the large Basilica, the old church, the Eucharistic Adoration Chapel, and the shrine's gift shop. Enjoy an evening at leisure. Mass\* requested at the Apparition site, Basilica or Old church. Rest of the day at leisure. Join your group for dinner at the hotel tonight.

> Dav 5: Friday. July 18 (part 1): Westport. Croagh Patrick. (B, D) Start the day traveling west to County Mayo on a panoramic drive to see Westport, the largest emigration port city on the northern half of Ireland. Travel to Croagh Patrick, where St. Patrick stayed for 40 days of penance, claiming for Christianity the tall mountain that was once dedicated to a pagan god. See beautiful views of the Clew Bay and the Atlantic. [Continued on next column]





Day 5: (Continued) Friday, July 18: Kylemore Abbey, Connemara. After a symbolic climb of Croagh Patrick (only a partial climb) praying the rosary, travel through the northern part of the Connemara National Park to see Kylemore Abbey, a magnificent historic mansion nestled in the woods, now belonging to the Benedictine nuns. From there, continue through the Connemara region and admire the sweeping views of boglands and misty mountains. As you drive along you will see many sheep that graze freely and also tracts of bogland where some people hand-cut peat for home heating. Drive by Connemara's most beautiful but saddest road, the "Famine Way", where we stop to pray by the Monument to the Famine, and learn about one of the greatest suffering times of the Irish people. End your day at your hotel located in Galway City. Join your fellow pilgrims for dinner. Mass\* requested at Kylemore Chapel.



Dav 6: Saturday, July 19: Cong. Corrib Cruise\*, Galway City. [3] Depart for Cong, a small village which was the filming location for the classic movie "The Quiet Man" (Maureen O'Hara and John Wayne). Visit the ruins of Cong Abbey by the river. After your visit to Cong, pending on weather, availability and time, we may take a cruise on Lake Corrib. Afterwards, continue to one of Ireland's most charming cities! Galway City has a unique festive atmosphere with lots of culture and heritage, overlooking Galway Bay. Explore old Galway where the balance of the day is at leisure for independent activities and dining. Eyre Square forms the hub of the city and contains the John F. Kennedy Memorial Park, where you can sit and peoplewatch. Many of the narrow streets, such as Shop Street, are pedestrianized and contain shops, pubs and teashops. Lynch's Castle dates from 1320, but is now a bank where portions of the medieval walls are still visible along Eyre Square. Enjoy a stroll along the rushing River Corrib, which links lake Corrib to Galway Bay. There is an abundance of eating and entertainment options! Galway City is famous for live folk music which streams out of every pub. Evening at leisure in Galway City with dinner on your own. Mass\* requested at St. Mary of the Rosary in Cong.

### Day 7: Sunday, July 20: County Clare & County Kerry. (E, D)

After Mass\*, drive around Galway Bay and pass through the Burren Country, an area of rocky limestone hills where a number of unique flowers thrive. This region also contains many dolmens, prehistoric monuments formed by large limestone slabs. Drive along the coastline of County Clare to view the Cliffs of Moher, one of the



country's most magnificent rock formations that rise to heights of almost 700 feet above the churning Atlantic swells. Afterwards cross the Shannon Estuary in a ferry and arrive in Tarbert. Continue the drive south until our arrival in County Kerry. After checking into your hotel this evening, join your fellow travelers for dinner. Mass\* concelebrated at either Galway Cathedral, Furbo

## Day 8: Monday, July 21: Ring of Kerry, Killarney. (B)

Today admire breathtaking vistas of mountains, cliffs and beaches on Ireland's most popular drive, The Ring of Kerry. See a variety of natural beauty as you drive 100 miles around this scenic route. A number of stops will allow you to admire the spectacular scenery. Head back to Killarney through Moll's Gap with stunning views of the Lakes of Killarney. Then travel to Killarney, to visit its beautiful Gothic Cathedral. Evening at leisure with dinner on your own in Killarney. Mass\* at St. Michael the Archangel or St. Patrick in the Ring of Kerry.

#### Day 9: Tuesday, July 22: Tipperary & Kildare. (B, D)


Say good-bye to County Kerry this morning and travel to the fertile



County Tipperary to visit the impressive "Rock of Cashel" Castle, seat of the High Kings of Ireland. Afterwards, travel to the county Kildare area (known as Ireland's horse country, and also the County of St. Bridget) for dinner and overnight. Mass\* in Tralee, Cashel or Kildare.

#### Day 10: Wednesday, July 23: Glendalough and Dublin. (B, D)

Travel County Wicklow (the garden) county of Ireland) to see the 6th century monastic ruins of Glendalough. Nestled in a valley surrounded by the mountains of Wicklow, Glendalough exudes the peacefulness so much desired for the contemplative prayer of the monks. St. Kevin founded this settlement and St. Lawrence O'Toole made it famous at a time when Christianity was burgeoning throughout Ireland. Today the monks are long gone, but have left the ruins of numerous tombs, chapels, Celtic Crosses and a round tower. After the tour, there will be free time to trek the trails. Travel to Dublin and enjoy a



memorable and festive welcome to Dublin/farewell dinner with all your fellow pilgrims. Mass\* requested at St. Kevin's chapel in Glendalough.

Day 11: Thursday, July 24: Dublin. [3] Start the day with a panoramic drive of Dublin City, featuring views of St. Patrick's Cathedral, Christchurch Cathedral, Dublin Castle, O'Connell Street, the Post Office (site of the 1916 Rebellion), River Liffey, the Half Penny Bridge, Grafton Street and St. Stephen's Green. Visit Trinity College to see The Book of Kells. Stop by St. James Gate to get acquainted with Ireland's most famous beverage (Guinness). Afterwards, we visit Immaculate Conception Church (Church of Adam & Eve) where the group celebrates its Farewell Mass\*. Enjoy a night at leisure in Dublin with dinner on your own.

#### Day 12: Friday, July 25, 2025: Return to USA. (B, M)

There will be only one bus transfer to Dublin Airport for all return destinations. After check-in, US Immigration & Customs will be processed in Ireland. Board your non-stop flight from Dublin to Chicago or Minneapolis. Relax as you return to the USA.
