Day 1) Sunday, March 16th, 2025: US departure. (M)

Meet your Mater Dei Tour Director at Chicago's O'hare Airport (*Packaged airfare is available from Chicago, IL. (other cities may be available for an add-on price - contact us for information).*) Board your flights to Barcelona via Lisbon.

Day 2) Monday, March 17th (St. Patrick): Arrival in Europe. (M, D)

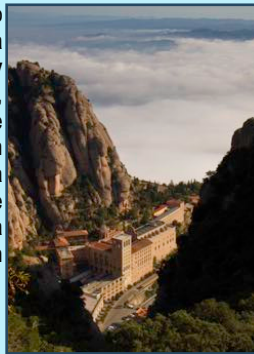
After a connection in Lisbon, arrive in Barcelona. Upon arrival, board your coach and drive towards the bulbous mountain range on the outskirts of Barcelona to reach the Montserrat area, where our hotel is located nearby. Welcome Mass to be celebrated today (likely at the airport chapel in Lisbon) Join your fellow pilgrims for a **welcome dinner**. Check into our hotel. Day 3) Tuesday, March 18th: Montserrat & Panoramic of Barcelona. (B, D)

After breakfast depart for the **Marian Monastery of Montserrat**, a magnificent and historical Marian Shrine visited by many saints over the centuries, including **St. Ignatius of Loyola**. Nestled above the clouds of Cataluña, the Shrine of Montserrat houses the image of **Our Lady of Montserrat** above the Altar, to whom

St. Ignatius surrendered his sword. Our group will try to attend other activities at the shrine like the escolania Children's Choir (pending on shrine's schedule. **Holy Mass*** to be celebrated in Montserrat. This afternoon, travel to **Barcelona** and enjoy a panoramic tour (from the bus) of the largest city and Capital of Cataluña. From Mont Juic, enjoy views of Gaudi's famous Sagrada Familia as well as other iconic places of Barcelona like the port. From the bus, see the Plaza de Cataluña, Plaza de Colón, and the famous Ramblas. Enjoy dinner with your group tonight at our hotel.

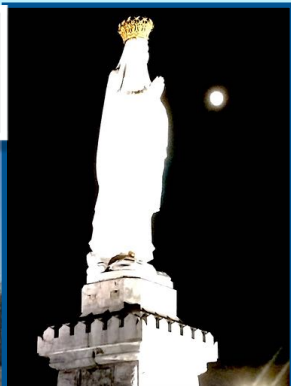

Day 4) Wednesday, March 19th (St. Joseph): Adios España, (temporarily) Bon Jour La France! Arrive in Lourdes. (B, D)

Depart Cataluña this morning heading towards Lourdes, France. Relax and watch the Lourdes Movie as you see beautiful sights along the way. Spiritual program onboard. After crossing the border into France, we continue to another one of the most famous Marian Shrines in the world, **Our Lady of Lourdes**. Upon arrival, we walk to the Shrine for **Holy Mass*** in one of the shrine's chapels. An **orientation walk** of the shrine's grounds follows. This evening, relax and freshen up for dinner at our hotel. After dinner, join pilgrims from around the world for the inspiring **Rosary "Torch Procession"**.

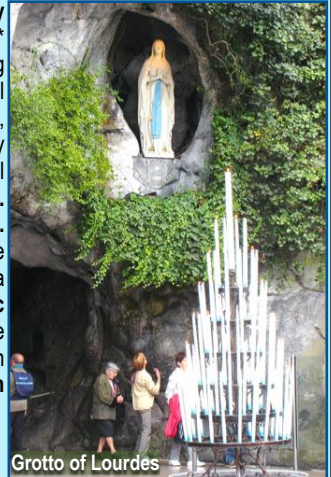

Day 5) Thursday, March 20th: Lourdes, France. (B, D)

Enjoy a special day in **Lourdes**. Begin with **Holy Mass*** at the **grotto** (site of the apparitions - Mass* will be concelebrated with other English speaking priests). Afterwards, you may opt for a personal day at leisure in Lourdes (time to go to the baths, participate in personal devotions, etc.) or you may want to follow your escorts on an informal **orientation walk** of the Lourdes of **St. Bernadette**, including sites like the **Mill**, where **St. Bernadette** was born, and the "**Cashot**," where Bernadette's family lived. At 5:00 pm, there is a **Eucharistic Procession with Eucharistic Adoration and Benediction**. The remainder of the day is at your leisure. After dinner join pilgrims from around the world for the inspiring **Rosary torch procession** at 9:00 pm.

Day 6) Friday, March 21st: Lourdes, France. (B, D) Your last day in **Lourdes** begins with **Holy Mass*** either concelebrated at the **grotto** of the apparitions or at a private chapel. Enjoy a personal day at leisure in Lourdes (time for Confessions, adoration and personal devotions — and also shopping). At 3:00 PM, those who wish, will gather for the **Way of the Cross** at one of the most spectacular Via Crucis sites ever! The remainder of the day is at your leisure either joining the shrine's scheduled activities or relaxing, praying and sightseeing. After enjoying dinner with your pilgrim family, join other pilgrims from around the world one last time for the **Rosary torch procession** at 9:00 pm.

Day 7) Saturday, March 22nd: Lourdes, Pamplona & Zaragoza. (B, D)

Our memorable visit to **Lourdes** ends as we embark on a relaxing journey crossing back into Spain circling the **Pyrenees Mountain Range**. Once we arrive in Spain again, continue towards the Capital of the Province of Navarra, **Pamplona***, made famous to Americans by Ernest Hemingway's novel, "The Sun Also Rises", which highlighted Pamplona's legendary "Running of the Bulls". Pamplona is also famous for being the place where St. Ignatius was injured defending the city, an act that commenced the process of his conversion. *Note: There may be route changes that may obligate us to switch this city for another one. Afterwards, head to **Zaragoza** to visit another world famous Marian Shrine, the "**Basilica/Catedral de Nuestra Señora del Pilar**" (Our Lady of the Pillar). **Mass*** will be celebrated either at Lourdes or El Pilar. Check-in at your overnight hotel and enjoy diner with your group (dinner may be at a local restaurant).

Day 8) Sunday, March 23rd: Zaragoza, Logroño & Santo Domingo de la Calzada. (B, D)

Our Lady of the Pillar



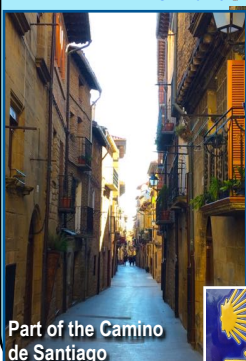
Start the day with Mass* at the "Basilica/Catedral de Nuestra Señora del Pilar" (Our Lady of the Pillar), located in the massive Plaza del Pilar (Pilar Square). This is where Our Blessed Mother appeared standing on top of a Pillar to the apostle St. James (Santiago). It is reputed to be the first ever recorded apparition of Mary (Year 40 AD — experts say it was actually a bilocation of Mary since she was not yet assumed into Heaven). This event happened while James was on his famous apostolic mission to Spain known as the "Camino de Santiago" (The Way of St. James), one of the world's most famous pilgrimage routes. Visit the chapel in the Basilica where the Pillar still stands. As a sign of fulfillment of your pilgrimage to Our Lady of the Pillar, we will have the opportunity to practice the local custom of kissing the venerable column (or Pillar) where Our Lady once stood (making it a relic of Our Blessed Mother). Depart Zaragoza heading north towards Logroño, but first, we will attempt a stop in the town of Agreda* (*pending approval to visit the convent), where the convent that houses the incorrupt body Venerable Maria de Agreda is located. Venerable Maria de Agreda was the Mother Superior who is credited with writing the "City of God". Afterwards, depart for Logroño, a city located near the borders of Aragon, Navarra and Castile, along the banks of the Ebro River (same river as Our Lady of the Pillar Shrine). We disembark from our coach just prior to reaching the town center and from that point, we start our "symbolic walk" on the famous Camino de Santiago! Pass the Church of Santiago and the place where St. Josemaria (Saint of the ordinary) was raised, as well as the place where he saw "the footprints in the snow" and received his vocation to the Priesthood. From there, we drive to Santo Domingo de la Calzada, a medieval town on the Camino, made famous by a saint who cared for pilgrims on the Way of St. James. If time allows, we once again walk a few final miles into town and check into our "Parador" hotel for dinner and a well-deserved rest.

Day 9) Monday, March 24th: Santo Domingo De La Calzada & Rioja Wine Region. (B, WTL*, D)

After breakfast we walk to Mass* celebrated at the Hermitage Church of Our Lady of the Plaza after which we tour the local Cathedral of Santo Domingo de la Calzada, the site of the famous Camino Miracle of the Hen and the Rooster. This is the only Catholic church in the world with live chickens enshrined in it (you must hear the story of the miracle to understand why). Then we travel to the world famous Rioja Wine Region, to visit a special winery with an amazing history dating back to Roman times! We will enjoy wine tasting and plenty of hors d'oeuvres to be considered a Wine Tasting Lunch! If time allows, we may incorporate a surprise visit today.

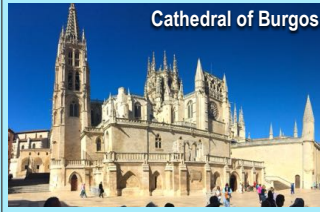

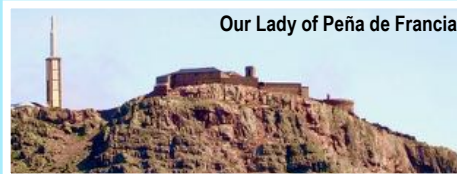
Day 10) Tuesday, March 25th (Annunciation): Burgos & Peña de Francia. (B, D)

After breakfast, board our motor-coach and head west, tracing the Camino walk until we arrive at the amazing Cathedral of Burgos where we find the tomb of the great "El Cid". A self-guided tour of the cathedral is included (Mass* celebrated here). After a lunch break, travel southwest towards the Marian Shrine of Our Lady of Peña Francia. Our bus will climb to the top of the rock (also known as Peña) called Francia (France), the place where the image of Nuestra Señora de Peña Francia (Our Lady of Peña Francia) was discovered by a French man who later changed his name to Simon Vela. The love and veneration to Our Lady under this title of Peña Francia, became famous in the Americas and the Philippines, due to the missionary fervor of the Dominican Religious who continue to be in charge of the Sanctuary. Our group enjoys dinner and overnight at the humble accommodations of the shrine built by Queen

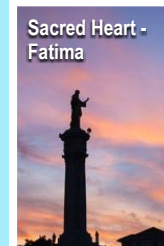

Afterwards, relax and enjoy the ride with views of the Portuguese countryside as we approach one of the world's holiest Marian Shrines, the Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima. This is the famous site where Our Lady appeared to 3 little shepherds in 1917. Lucia, the eldest of the 3 shepherds, eventually joined the Carmelite Order. Join your fellow pilgrims for dinner at our hotel. Afterwards, join pilgrims from all over the world while they pray the Holy Rosary at the Sanctuary grounds in a candle light procession [Light walking except for rosary procession] { } { } { }

Day 12) Thursday, March 27th: Fatima. (B, L, D)

Join us for a morning Way of the Cross and visit the sites of the

August 19th Marian Apparition as well as the apparition site of the Angel of Portugal. Also visit the homes of Saints Francisco and Jacinta (with a possibility of meeting relatives), as well as the home of Lucia's family. Return to the hotel for lunch - shopping time follows. You may otherwise opt to spend the whole day at the Fatima Shrine at leisure - with opportunity for Confessions, Rosary, Way of the Cross, Adoration to the Blessed Sacrament and personal prayer time. Mass* is celebrated at the Shrine in Fatima. Tonight, join your new pilgrim family for dinner. Rosary

procession follows for those who wish to participate again.

Purchaser and/or traveler of this tour (you) acknowledges that Landa Cleary Travel Company, Inc. (d.b.a. = doing business as Mater Dei Tours and Relevant Journeys) is acting as an independent intermediary (travel agent) between you and suppliers of goods and services, which are not directly supplied by Mater Dei Tours, such as air transportation, hotel accommodations, ground and sea transportations, tours, tour guides, escorts, etc. and shall not be responsible for actions or omissions on the part of such suppliers, which may result in any loss, damage, delay or injury to you or your travel companions or group members. Mater Dei Tours and any religious or private organization contracting its services shall not be responsible for any injuries, damages or losses caused to any traveler in connection with social or labor unrest, mechanical or construction difficulties, diseases, local laws, climatic conditions, war, terrorist activities or any other actions omissions, or conditions outside their control.

By embarking upon his/her travel, the traveler(s) voluntarily assumes all the risks, and is advised to obtain appropriate insurance coverage against them. Your booking shall constitute a consent to the above and engaging the company, acknowledges these conditions and agrees to hold the company blameless in making the arrangements on his/her behalf, and agrees that restitution or damages, if any are claimed, shall be sought directly from the suppliers.

Deposits: A deposit of \$500 per person is required to secure your space to Mater Dei Tours. Your deposits are used to cover and guarantee your space. **Deposits will be refunded in the event the tour does not meet the minimum quorum necessary to make the trip possible.** If you use a credit card as payment, you agree that if any cancellation penalties are due, Mater Dei Tours is authorized to charge the penalties to the credit card listed on the registration.

Final Payments: Full payment must be made no later than **100 days** prior to departure unless otherwise stated. Payments may be made by check, Visa, MasterCard, Discover or American Express. If payment is not received as scheduled, your reservation may be automatically canceled and your deposit payment is forfeited. If you use a credit card as payment, for your convenience, you may opt to have Mater Dei Tours charge your balance to the same authorized credit card on the registration form by simply calling us with your verbal authorization.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be received in writing to our company prior to tour departure during normal business hours (9:00am to 5:00pm CST, Monday through Friday). All Cancellations are subject to the following per person penalties prior to departure:

Tour Membership: To ensure a positive experience, Mater Dei Tours reserves the right to reject any client (before or during the trip at the expense of the traveler) whose conduct is incompatible with the interest of the group. Mater Dei Tours is not responsible for lost persons and for the expenses incurred while being lost. Each traveler assumes responsibility for staying with the group.

Travelers with Special Needs: Passengers who require attention must advise the tour operator at the time of booking. A qualified and physically able companion must accompany travelers who need such assistance and must assume full responsibility for their well being. Coaches are not equipped with wheelchair accessible ramps, therefore all tour members must be able to mount 3 to 5 steps into the coach. **Participants should expect to walk at least 1 to 3 miles minimum in one day.** Walking surfaces may at times be uneven. Mater Dei Tours is not responsible for denial of service by any suppliers.

Young Travelers: Travelers who are less than 18 years old on the departure date must be accompanied by an adult and must share the adult's accommodations. If a child will be traveling with adults other than the parents or with only one parent, it is highly recommended that a notarized letter be written by the parents or non-traveling parent granting authorization to travel, including the dates of travel. We suggest that you also contact the appropriate consulate and airlines because they may have additional requirements.

Roommate Assignments: Mater Dei Tours will make every reasonable attempt to find you a roommate. However, this is not guaranteed. If no roommate is found by the registration deadline, the passenger will have the option to upgrade to a single room (if available) by paying the single occupancy or cancel altogether with a full refund. Mater Dei Tours cannot be held responsible if the roommate you were assigned to is not agreeable to you. If you desire to get your own room, you will be responsible for all the financial consequences of such action, including but not limited to, covering the single occupancy costs of both you and your ex-roommate.

Air Transportation: We have selected airlines that are most suitable with land arrangements. All fares are subject to government approval and are subject to change without notice. Airfares are guaranteed once they have been paid in full and ticketed. Name changes required after tickets have been issued are subject to cancellation and re-ticketing at a higher fare and subject to change fees. Some airlines do not allow you to earn, and/or upgrade with frequent flier miles for group bookings.

Airline Seating: Passengers who require specific seating due to medical conditions are advised to obtain Doctor's Orders so the airlines may have proof of the condition and may accommodate the order. In addition to making the request through our company, please bring the doctor's note to the ticket counter. Passengers who desire a specific non-medical related seat are requested to contact the airline directly, approximately 30 days prior to departure for preferred seating. Group seating is under control of the airline and Mater Dei Tours can only pass on your requests.

Voluntary changes to itinerary: Independent voluntary changes to an individual passenger's itinerary are usually not permitted by most of our tour suppliers. Some exceptions may be granted in a case-by-case basis. All change requests must be made prior to 45 days before departure. If passenger purchased a land only package, they are free to plan their own itinerary before or after the trip (read Land Only bookings for restrictions).

Not Included: All items of a personal nature (room service, beverages, telephone charges, laundry, etc) and meals not specified on the tour itinerary are not included and must be paid by the passenger.

Accommodations and Itinerary: Land arrangements are provided as described in the tour program. The tour company reserves the right to change or substitute (1) hotels for accommodations in similar categories (2) or features of the itinerary in order to accommodate changes in the schedule.

Meals: Meals are provided as specified in the tour program. If you require special meals due to medical dietary restrictions, we must receive written details of your requirements at the time of booking. We cannot guarantee that each and every vendor will honor your requested diet, but every effort will be made to report and accommodate these requests. No weight loss plans or special nutrition diets can be accommodated.

Passports: Obtaining a passport is the sole responsibility of the passenger. Passports must be current and valid beyond the dates of travel. **Your airline ticket name must match your passport name or you may be denied boarding the airplane.** Passengers who are denied boarding due to discrepancies between ticket and passport names or because of expired passports accept full responsibility and are subject to the cancellation terms of the tour. Some countries, such as Israel, require that your passport expiration be 6 months beyond your travel dates. **We recommend that you apply for your passports (if needed) no later than 3 months before departure.**

Tips: Gratuities for baggage, hotel and restaurants detailed in the itinerary are included. **Gratuities for Tour Guide and Motor-coach Driver are NOT included** (unless otherwise stated in the brochure). Please read your "Essential Reading Material" (provided with your documents) for recommendations on tipping. Please budget accordingly.

Smoking: Smoking is not allowed on the motor-coach but frequent stops are made throughout the day.

Travel Health: This pilgrimage is being operated under the premise that it is safe to travel under the current health protocols. If governmental authorities and/or our tour vendors, declare that it is no longer safe to travel because of Covid-19 (or any other sickness), Mater Dei will need to cancel the pilgrimage. If all our vendors cancel their services, Mater Dei will issue a full refund to all. If a passenger cancels because of fear of Covid-19 (or any other sickness), but authorities still declare that it is safe to travel as long as people practice the appropriate advice to keep proper hygiene to avoid contamination, the passenger shall be assessed the appropriate cancellation penalty detailed in the first column. Please consider bringing a face mask (may be required by some airlines and/or foreign governments), especially if you are coughing and sneezing. If you are sick with Covid-19 or any other sickness, please stay home.

Total Group Cancellation: If it becomes necessary to cancel an entire tour prior to departure, Mater Dei Tours will offer the next available date or will make a full refund of money paid as soon as all our vendors refund us your money. Mater Dei Tours cannot accept responsibility for any additional costs, fees or cancellation penalties relating to any independent non-refundable purchases (personal airfares, travel insurance, etc.). If you use a credit card as payment, traveler agrees to forfeit 3% of all credit card charges to cover merchant fees absorbed by Mater Dei.
